15th – 18th February Dunblane, Scotland Celebrating 20 years of developing new talent

2022 is a special year for the Young Programme. It marks 20 years since our pilot event in Scotland in 2002. Our roll out across the UK and Ireland was complete very soon after that, but 20 years on, our aims are unchanged. They are: **enhancing communication skills, inspiring confidence, and broadening the intellectual horizons of people in the early years of their careers**.

Although the minimum age for taking part in the **Young Ireland Programme** (held annually in Scotland) is 18, **there is no upper age limit**: delegates may be young in years, or in terms of professional development, or both. People who have come late to a career, for example, are positively encouraged irrespective of age.

A central part of all of our courses is the presentation by each delegate of a 900-word paper ("Argument") on a topic – of the delegate's choice – of current interest or controversy. Researched, written and submitted in advance, the paper is delivered during the event. **Our coaches provide advice – in a written briefing before the programme and then in rehearsal before the papers are presented.**

And there's much more, including:

- guest speakers sharing their extraordinary life experiences in the Testimony sessions
- the Group Challenge in which delegates are divided into small discussion groups, allocated a topic, and given a short time to prepare an informal presentation
- and the 90 Second Challenge, in which delegates ask themselves a question on a subject of their own choice and answer it without notes

The entire event adds up to a rich and unique experience.

Everyone who completes the course receives a certificate – in recognition of an outstanding achievement. In addition, based mainly on the Argument paper, the title **Ireland Young Thinker** of the Year 2022 will be awarded to a delegate on the final evening.









FAQs

How does the programme benefit our delegate and our organisation?

By nominating a member or members of staff to take part in the Young Ireland Programme you will:

- enhance their communication skills and presentational abilities
- inspire them to have confidence in themselves
- expose them to a wide range of ideas, thoughts and life experiences

Where and when?

The venue is DoubleTree by Hilton Dunblane Hydro in Dunblane, a small town set in the beautiful Perthshire countryside. **Registration is in the afternoon of Tuesday 15th February. Delegates checkout after breakfast on Friday 18th February.** For delegates travelling from Dublin, we recommend Ryanair flight **FR 816** to Edinburgh on Tuesday and **FR 817** for the return on Friday. Courtesy transport between Edinburgh Airport and the hotel will be provided to connect with these flights.

Who's eligible?

People aged 18 or over who live and work in Ireland, and who are considered by their employers to be in the early stages of their careers. There is no upper age limit.

What is the delegate fee?

€1650 per delegate. This includes accommodation (single room occupancy) for three nights, all meals, and enrolment fee.

What information will delegates receive in advance of the event?

A pack including details of the event, guidelines, and travel advice will be sent to all delegates on Friday 7th January.
