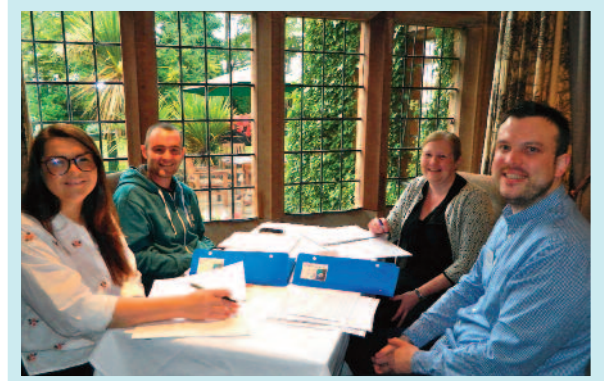

AUTUMN 2018 *Developing new talent*

The autumn **Young Scotland Programme** is a major highlight of the charity-run Young Programme calendar. Held concurrently with the annual Young Ireland Programme, the international mix of delegates under the same roof always engenders a vibrant and rewarding atmosphere.

As in all of our events, the core aims are to **develop communication skills, build confidence, and broaden the intellectual horizons** of people in the early years of their careers.

Although the minimum age is 18, **there is no upper age limit**: delegates may be young in years, or in terms of professional development, or both. People who have come late to a career, for example, are positively encouraged irrespective of age.

A central part of the course is the presentation by each delegate of a 900-word paper (“Argument”) on a topic – of the delegate's choice – of current interest or controversy. Researched, written and submitted in advance, the paper is delivered during the event. **Our coaches provide useful advice – in a written briefing before the programme and then in rehearsal before the papers are presented.**

And there's much more, including:

- ❖ guest speakers sharing their extraordinary life experiences in the **Testimony** sessions
- ❖ the **Group Challenge**, where small discussion groups are allocated a topic, and given a short time to prepare an informal presentation
- ❖ **On the Spot**, in which delegates ask themselves a question on a topic of their own choice and then answer it without notes in as close to two minutes as possible
- ❖ and **Yes, No, Don't Know**, a major debate on a big issue of the day

The entire event adds up to a rich and unique experience.

Everyone who completes the course will receive a certificate – in recognition of an outstanding achievement. In addition, based mainly on the Argument paper, the title **Scotland Young Thinker of the Year 2018** (a title shared with the winners of the two other Scotland programmes held this year) be awarded to a delegate on the final evening. There will also be an award for **Best Group** in the Group Challenge.

Where and when?

The venue is Doubletree by Hilton – Queensferry Crossing hotel in North Queensferry. Enjoying panoramic views of the Forth Bridges (right), the hotel is just 12 miles from Edinburgh city centre.



Registration is in the afternoon of Tuesday 18 September. Delegates will check-out after breakfast on Friday 21 September.

Who's eligible?

People aged 18 or over who live and work in Scotland, and who are considered by their employers to be in the early stages of their careers. There is no upper age limit.

What is the enrolment fee?

£1250 + VAT (total £1500) per delegate, inclusive of accommodation (single room occupancy) for three nights plus all meals.

What advice and information do delegates receive in advance?

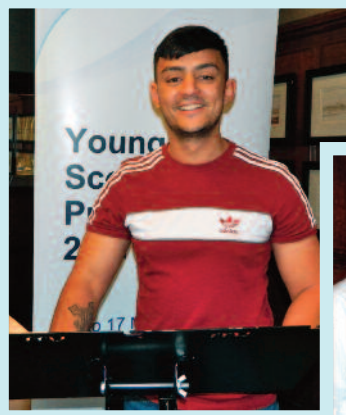
A delegate pack containing guidance on writing the Argument paper, details about other aspects of the course, travel information, etc will be sent to all delegates on the closing date for booking.
